

Windows Enterprise Announcement

May 30, 2013 – WINDC3 Domain Controller Unavailable June 4, 2013

ITS will continue converting the domain controllers to Windows Server 2008 R2 (a 64-bit operating system). The next domain controller to be converted will be WINDC3. The conversion is planned to take place on June 4, 2013 and WINDC3 will be unavailable most of the day.

Most users will not notice the outage of one domain controller. Windows domain member systems will automatically fail over to one of the four remaining domain controllers. However, if you have non-Microsoft systems that will not fail over and are pointed to windc3.iastate.edu (129.186.78.28) you will want to change that prior to June 4, 2013.
