- Windows systems using OpenAFS have a couple issues to be aware of.

First, if you use OpenAFS you should also install Kerberos for Windows. This issue was discussed at last month's meeting. See:

#### Windows Server 2008 DC Rollout – Steve Kunz [ITSYS]

The upgrade of the Windows Enterprise domain controllers to new hardware running Windows Server 2008 continues this summer. Since outages on individual domain controllers WILL occur, it is very important that IT admins with third party software that has to be manually configured to point to specific domain controllers be aware of the dates of outages. EVERY domain controller (WINDC1, WINDC2, WINDC3, and WINDC4) will undergo an outage sometime during June and July. The outage may last several hours. Normal Microsoft Windows domain members will not be affected by the outage of an individual domain controller (they will automatically find another).

WINDC4 will be upgraded on Tuesday, June 16, 2009. There will be an outage for WINDC4. The domain will be available. See:
