

## Windows Enterprise OU Administrator Tips

### Creating Group-Aware Logon Scripts

Microsoft provides some techniques on creating “group-aware” logon scripts in a Windows Active Directory environment. This method involves using a batch program called “ifmember.exe” to test for the logged-in user’s group membership to control the logon script. The “ifmember.exe” binary is a small 10 KB exe file and it does not have to be installed on every domain-member desktop system (you can place it on your departmental member server and execute it off the share).
